Night Market Stallholders Terms and Conditions

1. Akoonah Park Committee of Management (APCM) has Public Liability Insurance to cover the APCM
2. Stallholders should ensure that they have their own 'Public Liability Insurance' to cover themselves
3. Night Markets commence at 5.00pm and close at 9.00pm
4. Stallholders must be in place ready to trade by 4.30pm - stalls may be re-let after this time
5. All Vendors must complete a Stallholder application online at www.akoonahpark.com.au
6. Accepted applicants will be sent an invoice via email
7. All stalls are to be paid prior to trade either online via Eway or direct deposit into the Akoonah Park bank account

8. Refunds

Stall fees are non-refundable

We are an all-weather outdoor Market and stallholders must come prepared to trade in varying weather conditions

In the event that our Market is cancelled, we will offer a replacement stall at a later date

9. Night Market Stall Costs – from July 2019

Regular outside stall	\$50.00
Regular inside stall	\$50.00 - 3 metre trestle table supplied at stall
Power per lead	\$ 3.00
Food Stall (3m x 3m)	\$150.00 - Power inclusive
Food Stall (6m x 3m)	\$250.00 - Power inclusive
Coffee Stall	\$100.00 - Power inclusive

10. Trestle Tables

Trestle tables will be supplied for **indoor stalls only** during Night Markets

11. Marquees

Akoonah Park Market does not supply Marquees – All Marquees used at the Market must have weights attached

12. Vehicles

Vehicles are not permitted in the market area or after 4.30pm or before 9.15pm

Vehicles must be parked as specified by the market staff

Car parks in the first 3 rows of the main car park (west side of sheds) are for customers only

13. Stall Holders must not pack their goods prior to 9.00pm without permission from the Market Manager
14. Goods must remain within the white paint stall boundaries at all times.

15. APCM does not consent to the practice of Stallholders leaving goods within the market sheds at any time. Stallholders who leave goods at their site do so at their own risk and acknowledge that the APCM will not be liable for any loss or damage to goods whether by fire, water, theft or any other cause. If a table cannot be let due to goods being left on table(s) between markets then the Stall Holder must pay the normal rent due.
16. APCM reserves the right to cancel a Stall Holder's tenure at any time and without affording reason.
17. In accordance with the Electrical Safety Act 1998 all second hand electrical goods must be tagged and tested, stating that (a) the equipment is second-hand and the equipment has been inspected and tested and complies with Australian/New Zealand standard (AS/NZS) 3760 or (b) the equipment is second-hand with additional words;
'DANGER – DO NOT USE OR CONNECT TO SUPPLY – THIS ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT MAY BE FAULTY AND SHOULD BE INSPECTED BY A COMPETENT PERSON IN ACCORDANCE WITH AS/NZS 3760
18. Under section 96 of the Domestic Animals Act 1994, it is illegal to sell, offer or expose for sale pets at the Market.
19. APCM reserves the right to cancel the market due to extreme weather conditions
20. All items being sold at Acoonah Park Market must comply with product safety requirements under the Australian Consumer Law. For a complete list of mandatory safety standards, banned products and recalled products visit the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission's Product Safety Australia website at www.productsafety.gov.au
21. All vendors selling package and unpacked food need to make sure that their product has been clearly labelled with the country of origin as required under the Food Standards Code. www.foodstandards.gov.au
22. Products being sold by vendors at the market must not be counterfeit or in breach of copyright laws
23. Stallholders acknowledge these terms and conditions and agree to comply with, and be bound by them
